Slip on the ramp into the water	Possible(C)	Minor (2)	6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Safety Briefing by the Lifeguard outlines where to enter the water. • Enter and exit the water slowly. • Have a person controlling the flow during busy periods
Patron falls on one of the numerous obstacles	Likely (B)	Insignificant (1)	4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Safety Briefing by the Lifeguard: watch out for other patrons already on the obstacle that you are approaching & wait for them to finish. • Have a person controlling the flow during busy periods
Patron falls into and lands on another patron	Likely (B)	Minor (2)	8	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Safety Briefing by the Lifeguard: watch out for other patrons already on the obstacle that you are approaching & wait for them to finish. • Have a person controlling the flow during busy periods
Patron slips down an obstacle – the slide	Possible (C)	Minor (2)	6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Safety Briefing by the Lifeguard: • Take your time climbing the obstacles. One foot at a time. Wait for other patrons to finish climbing before you climb. • Have a person controlling the flow during busy periods
Falling in the Hamster Wheel	Possible (C)	Minor (2)	6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Safety Briefing by the Lifeguard: Only 2 people in the Hamster Wheel at any given time. • Have a person controlling the flow during busy periods.
Falling off the Rocker	Unlikely (D)	Minor (2)	4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Safety Briefing by the Lifeguard: Only 4 people on the Rocker at any given time. • Have a person controlling the flow during busy periods.
Injury from the Trampoline	Possible (C)	Minor (2)	6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Safety Briefing by the Lifeguard: • No flips on the Trampoline. • One person on the Trampoline at any given time. • Have a person controlling the flow during busy periods.
Injury from the Giant Slide	Unlikely(D)	Minor (2)	4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Safety Briefing by the Lifeguard: • One person down the slide at any given time. • No jumping down the slide. Sliding only.

				<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Water is 2 metres deep. Lifeguard supervising round the Slide Tower. Have a person controlling the flow during busy periods
Drowning	Rare(E)	Catastrophic (5)	5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Patrons have an appropriate level of swimming skill. Patrons wear a Life Jacket at all times. If Children are 9 & Under they need an Adult supervising them at all times. All Patrons attend the Safety Briefing before their session time. Have a person controlling the flow during busy periods
Injury Specific Falls & Winded	Possible (C)	Minor (2)	6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Patron wears properly fitted lifejacket. Lifeguard reminds all Patrons to be mindful of others on the Aqua Fun Park. First Aid Room with qualified First Aid Lifeguards & Customer Service staff. Have a person controlling the flow during busy periods

Face First	Possible (C)	Minor (2)	6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Patron wears properly fitted lifejacket. Behave sensibly out on the obstacles. Lifeguard to remind all patrons to be mindful of others on the Aqua Fun Park. First Aid Room with qualified First Aid Lifeguards & Customer Service staff. Have a person controlling the flow during busy periods
Head Injury	Possible (C)	Minor (2)	6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Patron wears properly fitted lifejacket. Behave sensibly out on the Obstacles. Lifeguard reminds all Patrons to be mindful of others on the Aqua Fun Park. First Aid Room with qualified First Aid Lifeguards & Customer Service staff. Have a person controlling the flow during busy periods
Slips over in the Aqua Fun Park	Possible (C)	Minor (3)	6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Remind patrons to not run inside the Aqua Fun Park. Wear shoes when entering and exiting the Park. Have a person controlling the flow during busy periods

Lightning strike	Possible (C)	Major (4)	12	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Regularly look at BOM weather site to check on weather updates.• Clear the Aqua Fun Park with severe weather warnings.• Lifeguards to keep an eye on the weather conditions.• Have a person controlling the flow during busy periods
